Hours

AGCS Before & After Care is held Monday-Friday, and follows the AGCS academic calendar.

ELC Before Care: 7:00 a.m. to 8:05 a.m.

ELC After Care: 3:15 p.m. to 6:00 p.m.

State Road campus does not provide Before Care however students will be transported to the ELC Campus for After Care from 2:15 p.m. to 6:00 p.m.



Enrollment

All students currently enrolled at AGCS between Kindergarten and 6th grade are eligible for our Before & After Care Program.

All students who want to attend our program must complete a registration form prior to starting and pay the required registration fee. Parents must also sign the AGCS extended care handbook.

Registration

Families interested in registering their student(s) for our Before & After Care Program should:

- Complete a family registration form (found on our website or can be emailed)
- Provide the required registration fee amount of \$30 per student or \$50 per family. This fee is non-refundable and holds your students' spot in the program
- Sign off on our AGCS extended care handbook



Invoicing

Invoices are handed out the second Friday of the month, leaving ample time for payment.

If a child is absent the day invoices are handed out, invoices will then be e-mailed to parents.

Tuition

We offer two options (3 days a week and 5 days a week); please see the next slide for pricing.

Our program is a commitment, therefore if there is ever a day your child is absent or on vacation, tuition payment is still required.

If you are interested in the 3 day a week option, it is crucial that you notify us which 3 committed days you are interested in attending the program.

Tuition Policy

All tuition payments are due the **1st of the month** from September through June. Payments can be made via cash, check, or on our online payment system at

Tuition payments will be pro-rated for the month of June only as school is only in session for partial time.



Late Fees

A late fee of \$15.00 will be assessed if payment is not received by the first of the month.

A late fee of \$1.00 per minute will be assessed if a student isn't picked up by 6:00 p.m. The program closes promptly at 6:00 p.m.

Schedule

Monday through Friday

- 7:05 am - 8 am or 3:15 pm - 6 pm

Before & After Care will not be available on scheduled days off and holidays.

Before & After Care will be available on half days at the ELC Campus, unless otherwise noted. State Road students will be transported to ELC.

Inclement Weather Schedule

There will be times when AGCS opens late or closes early due to inclement weather.

Before Care will not operate if there is a delay. After Care families will be contacted directly via email and School Messenger as we monitor the weather conditions.

Child Pick-Up Procedure

Parents are required to come into the building to pick up their child. Each parent must sign their child out before leaving.

For the safety of our students, staff will ask for a photo ID from any person not recognized.

If an emergency situation prevents a parent from picking up their child by the scheduled time, the staff must be contacted.



Communication

Teachers work in partnership with parents to communicate on a regular basis.

If your child is enrolled in the program, it is crucial to notify both childcare staff and the students' teacher of any transportation changes and/or newly enrolled or withdrawn students from the program.
