THE PROBLEM

- Young children and teenagers are at risk on the internet.
- Parents are often unaware of how strangers can access their children in their homes.



PROCESS

- Social media platform algorithms scan for child exploitation material, including images of themselves to peers
- Next steps:
 - Find location
 - Search warrant
 - Identify children in photos
 - Child may face criminal charges


REALITY CHECK

• Nothing is ever deleted online!



RED FLAGS

- The most common tactics used to entice children include:
 - Sexual conversation/role-playing as a grooming method



- Rapport through interaction such as compliments, shared interests or liking posts as a grooming method
- Portraying themselves as younger
- Offering incentives
 - Gift cards, alcohol, drugs, lodging, transportation or food

- · Parents can:
 - Check their child's device anytime
 - Give consent to teachers and police
 - Invade their online privacy



COVID IMPACT

- Forced use of internet communication for predators and children.
- The Number of Online Solicitation Reports nearly doubled from 2019 to 2020.
- The use of the internet and social media by schools and parents helps to validate this as a means for engaging to children.

TACTICS

- The internet has changed the pace of dating and the false sense of security and distance have reduced the barriers to revealing personal information.
- The topic of sex can be brought up in as little as 3 minutes.
- The topic of an in-person meeting in as little as 18 minutes.

TYPES OF OFFENDERS

- The blunt offender makes little attempt to mask their desires.
- The groomer attempts to connect, to fill an emotional need of the victim.
 - They may engage in layered chatting schemes to create believability and can be impulsive.
